# REMOTE LEARNING TERM TWO

## YEAR 11 & 12 STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

1

Students are expected to follow their usual school timetable each day. This also applies to those students continuing to learn from home.

Teachers will facilitate student learning through a combination of direct teaching, assigned class work and weekly written tasks. Work requirements will also be uploaded to SEQTA for students to access.

Students engaging in remote learning (from home) are required to complete all tasks assigned to the class. Teachers will provide direction on how to submit required work and will provide feedback to students on their progress.

Vocational students enrolled in external Certificate courses are to continue with these courses on their normal scheduled day. This may involve attending TAFE or accessing online lessons from home.

In situations where students work placements are not running, students are required to attend school on their allocated work placement day.

Students learning from home are encouraged to use SEQTA Direct Message and posts on MS Teams to ask questions of their teachers.
