## COVID-19 UPDATE

Dear Students, Parents and Carers,

I hope this message finds all members of our College community safe and well.

I write to inform you that due to yesterday's announcement by the State Government and the Health Department of Western Australia of a five-day Covid-19 Lockdown, Saint Norbert College will not be open to our Students or our Staff throughout this week. The College will continue to monitor relevant health advice over the coming days, but I wish to outline the following directions for this week.


- As directed by the State Government, Saint Norbert College will be closed to all Students and all Staff for the week commencing Monday 1 February up to and including Friday, 5 February 2021.
- Pending further health advice and formal confirmation, we plan to commence the Academic year on **Monday, 8 February**. **All students (Year 7 -12)** will commence at this time and further details will be forwarded throughout the week detailing this commencement.
- All students should use this week to begin preparations for the academic year ahead. From Tuesday morning, 2 February, all students in Year 7 – 11 are required to utilise SEQTA to access their individual Timetable in order to complete the following:
  - Become familiarised with aspects of the particular Subject/Course Outline**Please note that remote learning will not take place this week.**
- Year 12 students are required to utilise SEQTA to access their individual Timetable in order to complete the following:
  - Become familiarised with aspects of the particular Subject/Course Outline, including the downloading of SCSA syllabus documents as necessary.
  - Complete any preparatory tasks as directed by the Class Teacher, which may include a review of Year 11 work completed in 2020.**Mr Hawke will email all Year 12 students with further details and expectations.**
- All students across the College are encouraged to focus on their personal reading this week.

Please direct any teaching and learning queries to your child's classroom teacher or pastoral concerns to their relevant Head of House.

The College will continue to monitor government directives, relevant health advice and information from Catholic Education Western Australia (CEWA) to ensure that our College responds appropriately while ensuring the welfare and safety of everyone in our community.
